



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CONTRACT 6001

BRADSHAW EQUALIZATION STRUCTURE (BES) PIPELINE PROJECT

Regional San is advertising for bids for the construction of the Bradshaw Equalization Structure (BES) Pipeline Project at the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRWTP). The project consists of furnishing and installing approximately 2,350 feet of an 8-inch effluent nitrate line from the Flow Equalization Basin to the Bradshaw Equalization Structure. The 8-inch line will partly be within existing 36-inch and 60-inch storm drains and manholes along the way to the Bradshaw Equalization structure.

There will be a **mandatory** pre-bid conference and walk-through for prime contractors at 2:00 p.m., April 6, 2018 (unless changed by addendum) at the SRWTP Administrative Building, Commons Room at 8521 Laguna Station Road, Elk Grove, CA, 95758. Subcontractors are not required to attend. Attendees should be prepared to walk approximately one mile during the tour. Attendees must email Amanda Morrow at BES@sacsewer.com with attendee names prior to the meeting.

A general engineering contractor, class A license is required.

The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$725,000

There is no cost to access and download contract documents, however registration is required.

All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes: 1) The Davis Bacon Act, and 2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: The County of Sacramento received final approval from the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994. All questions regarding this Labor Compliance Program and prevailing wage requirements should be directed to the Labor Compliance Section at (916) 875-2711. In accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code, the payment of the general prevailing rate of per diem wages or the general prevailing rate of per diem wages for holiday and overtime is not required for any public works project of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or less when the project is for construction work, or for any public works project of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or less when the project is for alteration, demolition, repair, or maintenance work.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.

Pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1720 and following, and Section 1770 and following, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of the prevailing wage determinations are on file at the office of the County of Sacramento Labor Compliance Program, 9700 Goethe Road, Suite D, Sacramento, CA 95827, and are also available on the internet at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>.

A Contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, or be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.
