



## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS CONTRACT 4385

### CHANNEL AERATION BLOWER (CAB) PROJECT

Regional San is advertising for bids for the construction of the Channel Aeration Blower (CAB) Project at the Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (SRWTP). The project consists of construction of one concrete masonry unit blower building to contain four new turbo blowers and ancillary equipment; the modification of an existing equipment gallery to contain three new turbo blowers and ancillary equipment; the installation of blower distribution header piping in existing underground pipe tunnels; and the demolition of three existing centrifugal blowers and associated piping and appurtenances.

There will be a **mandatory** pre-bid conference and walk-through for prime contractors at 09:00 am, March 27, 2018 (unless changed by addendum) at the SRWTP Administrative Building, Commons Room at 8521 Laguna Station Road, Elk Grove, CA, 95758. Subcontractors are not required to attend. Attendees should be prepared to walk approximately one mile during the tour. A general engineering contractor, class A license is required.

The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$12,970,000

There is no cost to access and download contract documents; however, registration is required.

This Project is being substantially funded by a loan from a Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program. Project requires posting CWSRF Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) solicitations for bids or proposals for a minimum of 30 calendar days before the bid opening date.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5

All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes:

- (1) The Davis Bacon Act, and
- (2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.

Copies of the minimum wage rates established by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Labor ([www.wdol.gov](http://www.wdol.gov)) and the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (<http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>) are on file at the office of the Labor Compliance Program, 9700 Goethe Road, Suite D, Sacramento, California 95827, and are available upon request.

The County will not accept lower State wage rates not specifically included in the Federal Minimum Wage Decision. This includes “helper” (or other classifications based on hours of experience) or any other classification not appearing in the Federal Wage Decision. Where the Federal Wage Decision does not contain the State wage rate determination otherwise available for use by the Contractor and subcontractors, the Contractor and subcontractors shall pay not less than the Federal minimum wage rate which most closely approximates the duties of the employees in question.

The County of Sacramento received final approval from the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994.
